



Not only does the packaging have to be user-friendly and easy to open for those with reduced hand functionality, it also needs to prevent children from getting to the contents. It should meet the requirements in terms of tightness and light transmission, while also being cost-effective to produce.

It should be possible to manufacture the cap as a complete unit, and it should be easy to incorporate desiccants. After filling, it should be easy to attach the cap to the container, and when the packaging reaches the consumer it should be immediately obvious if it has been already opened.



Our technology is tailor-made to meet your unique requirements

We are one of the leading European specialists in injection blow moulding, with our modern, safe production techniques that are tailor-made to meet our customers' unique requirements in terms of effective manufacturing of plastic packaging for the pharmaceutical industry.

As well as injection blow moulding, which offers optimal control over neck and cap attachment, and is used primarily for high volume, high end packaging, we also offer extrusion blow moulding and injection stretch blow moulding for packaging with lower requirement specifications. We also use pure injection moulding and double injection moulding (2K) for manufacturing caps and other components.

To ensure a high level of production quality and delivery reliability, we have our own mould departments with highly trained mould makers, who can build new moulds and quickly adapt and repair them when necessary.

Post-treatment for packaging is also carried out at our own plants, where we can offer various types of printing and labelling. We also solve logistic needs and support the customer in handling the irradiation process.

Quality

The right quality and environmentally-friendly products We know what it takes to ensure you are satisfied

Our policy is always to meet our customer's exacting requirements and expectations, which in practice means always delivering the right quality, in the right quantity, at the right time.

We are certified in accordance with ISO 9001 and ISO 15378, which means that we also meet the requirements of Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP).

The highly automated production at our three plants conforms with strict hygiene requirements (class 8 in general) to prevent product contamination. In the event of stricter requirements, we can manufacture products in class 7 clean rooms.

During the production process the packaging is checked in-line using various technologies such as vision and leakage test systems to detect any defects. Other important parameters, such as opening force, axial strength and dimensions, are also checked continuously during production. All this ensures that we can meet our objective:

100% customer satisfaction.

A focus on GMP

When producing packaging for pharmaceuticals and VMS, we follow GMP. This includes full batch documentation, whereby traceability of products and raw materials is part of our standard procedures. Batch documentation is retained for at least five years, and most of the products are listed in a type III Drug Master File with the FDA.

Unique products can also comply with the requirements of ISO 13485 as well as CE, UN, Kitemark and NF.

Environmentally-friendly products are a matter of course

Sustainability is extremely important to us. We are environmentally certified in accordance with ISO 14001, and are committed to continuously developing products with minimal environmental impact.

Our products are therefore recyclable, and are based on monomaterials with low levels of resource consumption. One good example is a new VMS packaging, for which the carbon footprint has been reduced by 45 percent and production costs have been halved compared with the customer's previous packaging.

But we won't allow ourselves to simply be satisfied with this. Instead, we will continue to think about how we can improve on our existing products. Take our top-selling SC cap, for example. Thanks to further development, we now use 30 percent less plastic raw material than we did previously. This has reduced our resource consumption during manufacturing and when transporting the finished product.
